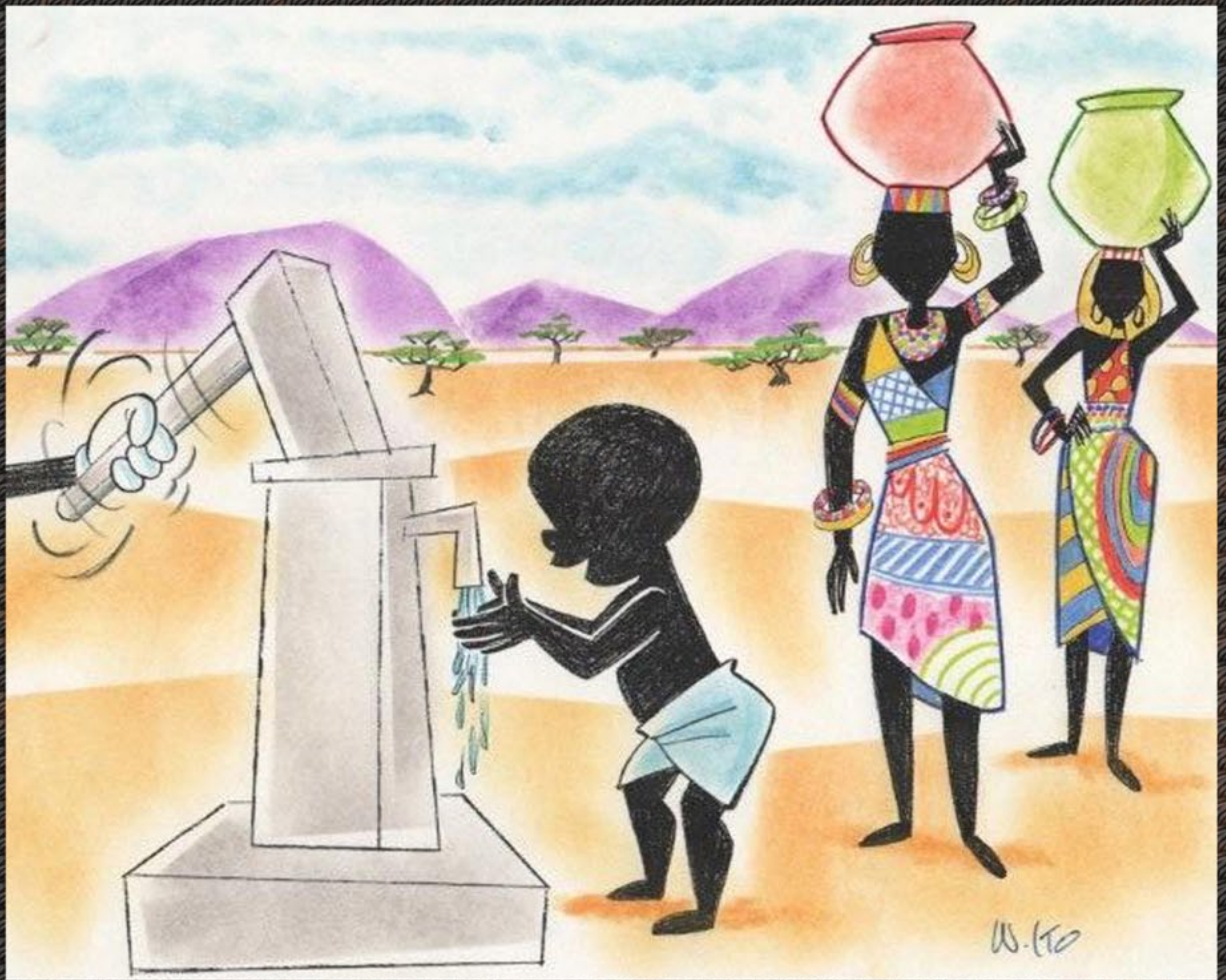


# GIVING A HELPING HAND.
